### **Who are we looking for?**

The right people will love cycling and will want to see others enjoying the sport as much as they do. You will need to be dedicated, friendly and outgoing. You will enjoy road riding and mountain biking and be fit and capable to ride reasonable distances.

A driver's licence is essential and staff need to be based in the South East. You also need to be a morning person!!

There is no requirement to be an existing Evans Cycles employee to apply for these roles.

### **Working period & benefits**

The events take place every second weekend and alternate between an event in the South East and one further away each month. This means you will be working every second weekend and be away from home one weekend a month (this will vary and staff flexibility is required).

Staff will receive the following benefits:

- Paid while travelling to and from events
- Hotel accommodation while away from home
- Travel expenses (flights, train etc)
